# **Family of Alexander Kirkpatrick**

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#### Generation One

Alexander's birthplace of Drumcondra House is suspect... the extant building was built in 1726 for Sir Marmaduke COGHILL (1673 - 1738), who had lived nearby at Belvedere House. By 1842, it had been converted to a Jesuit Seminary.

Drumcondra House built in 1726, is believed to be one of the finest examples of a large house built in the style of the 18th century. This type of early Georgian house is typically large, rectangular in shape, with two or three stories. Drumcondra house (renowned for its gardens) was designed by the architect Sir Edward Lovett Pearce to replace an earlier slated house "of fair stone" [CS1654] built by the Catholic Booth family before Drum Conragh was granted to the Coghills. Pearce was commissioned by Sir Marmaduke Coghill of Belvedere House.

Sir Marmaduke Coghill (1673 -1738) was remarkable for his early display of ability. At the age of 14 he entered Dublin University (Trinity College); at the age of 18 he graduated as a bachelor of laws; at the age of 19 he was returned to parliament; and at the age of 26 he became judge of the prerogative court. He became Chancellor of the Exchequer in 1735 and was regarded as an honest and able supporter of Irish interests. Sir Marmaduke loved the house, especially the gardens. He never married and lived in Drumcondra House with his unmarried sister, Mary. At his death she was left, for her lifetime, his lands in the barony of Coolock, rents from his properties in Clonturk, all his household goods, and his coach, chariot and horses. In 1743, she erected the parish church of Clonturk (now Drumcondra Church) in his memory, and placed in it a statue of her brother by the Dutch sculptor Peter Scheemakers.

Upon Mary Coghill's death the house was left to their niece, Hester Coghill, who married Charles Moore, then second Lord Tullamore, and afterwards Earl of Charleville. Hence, Drumcondra House was, for a time, the residence of the Countess of Charleville. After that, Drumcondra house (including its offices, demesne and lands) was let to tenants:

The Countess of Charleville leased Drumcondra House to Alderman Alexander Kirkpatrick of Dublin Corporation, a former high sheriff.

Of all the tenants who lived in it afterwards, John Claudius Beresford (1766-1846) is the one that is most remembered. He is known for his cruelty to the United Irishmen insurgents. During the Irish Rebellion of 1798 Beresford fought against the rebels with a particular ferocity, and hunted them down. It is said that

many of them were hanged in front of Drumcondra House (from a large chestnut tree which stood there until 1952).

The soldier Major General Sir Guy Campbell K.C.B. was the last resident in the House, who rented it from the Coghill family.

For most of the 18th and 19th century, Drumcondra consisted of parks, fields and a few farmhouses. It boasted only three 'big houses' of note; Drumcondra Castle (townland of Richmond, b.1560) which was overshadowed by Drumcondra House (townland of Drumcondra b.1726), and Belevedere House (townland of Drishoge; b.1660). Indeed, on any normal day, nothing more exciting happened in Drumcondra than the trundling through of mail-coaches to the main centres in the North.

In 1842 Drumcondra House was rented to a Catholic priest named Father John Hand who wanted to establish a centre where young priests were trained as missionaries. He chose Drumcondra House as his headquarters and he centre became known as "The Missionary College of All Hallows" which was run by the Vincentian order. Fr. Hand chose the name because the land where Drumcondra House had been built had once belonged to the Monastery of All Saints (All Hallows is another word for All Saints). However, many people did not know this and often misspelt this as "All Hollows" or even "Old Hollowes". The college was opened officially on the Feast Day of All Saints, November 1st 1842. The first students soon arrived and when student numbers grew, many new buildings were added to Drumcondra House. All Hallows missionaries were sent all over the world, as far away as India, the island of Mauritius, the West Indies, South Africa and Australia.

Today, All Hallows College is still run by the Vincentian order, and is now a college of Dublin City University. Students can study a number of subjects there such as Philosophy, Theology and Psychology.

FOSTER, COLLEY LYONS LUCAS, army and militia officer; b. 1778 in Ireland; m. first 1813 Elizabeth Kirkpatrick in Clonsilla parish (Republic of Ireland), and they had seven children; m. secondly 4 Feb. 1836 Ellen Humphreys in Toronto, and they had one son and two daughters; d. 7 May 1843 in Kingston, Upper Canada.

Colley Lyons Lucas Foster was commissioned in the English militia in 1798, and then entered the 52nd Foot when it raised a second battalion in 1799. He served in England and Ireland until 1804, much of the time as adjutant, and was promoted lieutenant in 1800 and captain in 1804. Between 1804 and 1811 Foster was in Jamaica as aide-de-camp and military secretary to the lieutenant governor, Sir Eyre Coote, and the governor, the Duke of Manchester. After returning to England he served briefly in Jersey, and then became aide-de-camp to Lieutenant-General Gordon Drummond\* in Ireland.

In 1813 Foster accompanied Drummond to his new command in Upper Canada. He was soon immersed in the war on the Niagara frontier, and after the taking of Fort Niagara (near Youngstown), N.Y., in December, he was selected to convey the captured American colours to Governor Sir George Prevost\*. On 7 Feb. 1814 Foster was appointed adjutant general of the Upper Canadian militia, and he took up additional administrative responsibilities as Drummond's military secretary. He was twice mentioned in dispatches by Drummond for his efforts in the headquarters at the siege of Fort Erie that summer.

With the conclusion of the war Foster was moved to Quebec, and gave up his militia appointment to Nathaniel Coffin. In 1816 he was appointed assistant adjutant general to the regular forces in Upper Canada, a post he held until his death. He was promoted lieutenant-colonel in June 1815 and colonel in January 1837.

Like other officers who served in the War of 1812, Foster received extensive land grants and speculated in the undeveloped land. His grants, totalling 1,200 acres, chiefly in Ancaster, Clinton, Thorold, and Cartwright townships, were sold to finance both his purchase of a town-lot in Kingston and a small farm near the town and the construction of buildings on these properties.

From June 1824 until September 1827 Foster acted as deputy adjutant general to the army in the Canadas. In this position he was called upon to act frequently for Governor Lord Dalhousie [Ramsay] on ceremonial occasions, and to be his military secretary. Foster petitioned for permanent appointment as deputy adjutant general, but his hopes were dashed by the arrival of Colonel Sir Thomas Noel Hill.

With the withdrawal of nearly all regular troops from Upper Canada in 1837, Foster succeeded to the command of the remaining handful of soldiers. When William Lyon Mackenzie's insurgents prepared to march down Yonge Street early in December, Foster played a leading part in organizing and arming a guard from among the citizens of Toronto. On 7 December, when Lieutenant Governor Sir Francis Bond Head marched against Mackenzie with a small force, he declined Foster's services, preferring that the issue be decided by inhabitants of the province. Once Head's resignation became effective in January 1838, Foster, as senior officer, took command of the militia and regular forces in Upper Canada until the arrival of Major-General Sir George Arthur\* in March. He had at times 15,000 militia under arms during this period, but he did not take the field personally. After the rebellion, Foster reassumed his duties as assistant adjutant general. In his last years he was concerned to sell his commission and retire, but he died while still on service.

Colley Lyons Lucas Foster had served out his life as a competent military administrator. He never commanded troops in the field beyond his subaltern service, but he soon caught the eye of senior commanders and rose through their personal staffs to responsible positions in war and peace.

1823: Settled in Kingston, Frontenac County, Ontario

1838: Although elected first mayor of Kingston in 1838, he was later disqualified as he was not a resident, He was re-elected in 1847 as Kingston's second mayor.

c. 1845: Bought lease for the Wolfe Island ferry from John and George IRIS (but had no interest in Wolfe Island affairs.)

1861: Lived in Kingston in a two storey house, with two horses, 2 cows on a land area of 2/10 acre. Four servants lived with the family; Enumeration district: Sydenham Ward, Kingston. Note that the house he is erroneously stated of building, "Stone Gables" is in Victoria Ward. The 1860 H.W. WALLING map shows only Alwington House, and that of James MORTON, Brewery owner, and the extensive buildings of the Kingston Brewery,

1858: Sold St. Helen's on the property east of Alwington House to James MORTON.

In 1860, his offices were on Ontario Street, (H,E. WALLING map),

1860 - 1861: Shown as living on Emily Street, Kingston. The Daily British Whig on 21 April 1855 reported that Thomas Kirkpatrick had just finished a "handsome and spacious edifice in the Cottage Ornée style...looking on the open lake" designed by John Power.

The 1860 H.E. WALLING map of Frontenac County shows a "T. Kirkpatrick" on Emily Street,

1865: Thomas lived at the Emily Street House (Kingston City Directory, 1865)

In 1866, the house was advertised for sale "enlarged and improved." (Daily British Whig, 6 April 1866).

Several websites have him incorrectly building Stone Gables, at 462 King Street West in Kingston, but that is not the same building extant on the site today; Kirkpatrick died in 1870, the present "Stone Gables" was built in a Tudor Revival fashion in 1929. The architect was David SHENNAN. It is more likely that he bought St. Helen's, the adjacent property, and likely built by Baron Grant, and subsequently bought by James MORTON in 1858 and renamed "Mortonwood."

KIRKPATRICK, THOMAS, lawyer and politician; b. 25 Dec. 1805 at Coolmine House, Clonsilla, near Dublin (Republic of Ireland), fourth son of Alexander Kirkpatrick and Marianne Sutton; m. in 1829, Helen, daughter of Alexander Fisher, a judge of the Midland District of Upper Canada, and they had five sons and three daughters; d. 26 March 1870 at Kingston, Ont.

Thomas Kirkpatrick came to Canada in 1823 and settled at Kingston where he read law in the office of Christopher Hagerman\*. He was called to the bar in 1828 and established a flourishing practice in Kingston. From 1828 until 1845 he was collector of customs at Kingston, a lucrative position he probably owed to the influence of Hagerman whom he succeeded in the post. He became a QC in 1846.

Although he was not considered a brilliant lawyer, Kirkpatrick was a successful one and had a reputation for integrity and soundness of judgement especially in business matters. He was president of the Kingston Permanent Building Society and was the local solicitor of the Bank of Upper Canada from about 1837 until its collapse in 1866 and local solicitor to its trustees until his death. He was also a director of the bank on six occasions between 1846 and 1853 and a trustee of the property of James Morton, one of the bank's largest debtors.

Kirkpatrick was a staunch Conservative who was influential in Kingston and Frontenac County politics; he took an active interest in local affairs. He was elected first mayor of the town of Kingston in 1838 but had to be disqualified as a non-resident. In 1847 he was elected as the city's second mayor. After being defeated by Alexander Campbell in a bid for the Legislative Council in 1858, he became Member of Parliament for Frontenac in the first Dominion Parliament in 1867.

Kirkpatrick was an example of the sober upper middle class which ruled the cities and towns of Ontario until the end of World War I. Kirkpatrick's descendants retained their influence in Kingston after his death; his son, George Airey\*, succeeded his father as MP and in 1892 was appointed lieutenant governor of Ontario.

KIRKPATRICK, Sir GEORGE AIREY, lawyer, militia officer, politician, office holder, and businessman; b. 13 Sept. 1841 in Kingston, Upper Canada, son of Thomas Kirkpatrick\* and Helen Fisher; m. first 25 Oct. 1865 Frances Jane Macaulay (d. 1877), daughter of John Macaulay\*, and they had four sons and one daughter; m. secondly 26 Sept. 1883 Isabel Louise Macpherson, daughter of David Lewis Macpherson, in Paris, and they had a son; d. 13 Dec. 1899 in Toronto.

George Airey Kirkpatrick was descended from the Irish branch of the barons of Closeburn, Scotland. His father, a son of Alexander Kirkpatrick, high sheriff of the city and county of Dublin, came to Upper Canada in 1823 and became a successful lawyer, politician, and businessman in Kingston. George grew up in an elegant country villa (St Helen's) and, after 1852, at Closeburn within the city's limits. He attended the best schools, including the local grammar school and the high school in St Johns (Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu), Lower Canada. After studying at Queen's College, Kingston, for a session, he entered Trinity College, Dublin, where he graduated in 1861 with a BA and an LLD, having distinguished himself as a moderator and silver medallist in law, literature, and political economy.

Because he had a law degree, Kirkpatrick had to article for only three years, which he served in his father's firm. He was called to the bar in 1865 and became, according to David Breakenridge Read\*, the "most prominent lawyer of his day in Kingston." His law firm remained active throughout his lifetime, and it survived him under the direction of his partners and business associates Robert Vashon Rogers and William Folger Nickle\*. Appointed qc in 1880, Kirkpatrick received honorary LLDs from Trinity College (1884), Queen's (1893), and the University of Toronto (1894).

Kingston in the 19th century was home to a number of powerful politicians, including Sir John A. Macdonald, Sir Alexander Campbell, Sir Richard John Cartwright\*, and Sir Oliver Mowat\*. In 1870, without much local political experience, Kirkpatrick defeated Cartwright's cousin and succeeded his own father as Conservative MP for Frontenac, the largely rural riding surrounding Kingston, which he would represent for the next 22 years. During that period he sat as chairman of the standing committee on public accounts (which brought forth the Tariff Act of 1879), served as speaker of the House of Commons from 1883 to 1887, and was appointed to the Privy Council in 1891. None the less, he spent his political career in the shadow of the more prominent Kingston politicians. A minor figure in parliament, he was unable to secure a cabinet post and even flirted with the Liberal party at the time of the Pacific Scandal in 1873 [see Sir Hugh Allan\*]. In refusing him a place in cabinet in 1888, Macdonald bluntly told him: "You are not strong enough in the House, when you were Speaker of the Commons you were afraid of [Edward Blake\*], and decided Parliamentary questions against your Conservative friends."

In the commons, in fact, he was a forceful advocate for the interests of Kingston, its businesses, Queen's, and the Royal Military College of Canada [see Edward Osborne Hewett], and for the expansion of the Great Lakes—St Lawrence canal system that was so important to the economy of Kingston and other Ontario ports. He took a particular interest in legislation in 1877 establishing a court of maritime jurisdiction in Ontario. He was appointed lieutenant governor of Ontario on 28 May 1892, during the Mowat administration, and served until 18 Nov. 1897, in which year he was created a K.C.M.G.. While lieutenant governor, in 1894—95 he was instrumental with Dr George Ansel Sterling Ryerson\* in the establishment in Toronto of the first Canadian branch of the St John Ambulance Association.

Public office was not a full-time occupation for Kirkpatrick. He had entered the militia as a private during the Trent affair in 1861 [see Sir Charles Hastings Doyle\*]. He saw active service at Cornwall during the Fenian raids of 1866, at which time he was adjutant of the 14th Battalion of Rifles. The following year he transferred to the newly formed 47th (Frontenac) Battalion of Infantry as a major, rising to lieutenant-colonel in 1872 and retiring in 1890. In 1876 he commanded the Canadian rifle team at Wimbledon (London), England, and he was president of the Dominion Rifle Association in the 1880s. His military interests were shared by his son George Macaulay Kirkpatrick, who graduated from RMC and went on to become commandant of the Royal Engineers (1927–30). George Airey Kirkpatrick also had extensive commercial interests, most notably as president of the Canadian Locomotive and Engine Company in Kingston from 1882 until his death and as a director of the Canadian Pacific Railway from 1886.

Kirkpatrick, whom historian Donald Wayne Swainson has called a "political patrician," clearly felt obliged to promote the well-being of the community in which he was a leader. In turn he was widely respected. A few years after his death in 1899, Liberal MPP Edward John Barker Pense obtained money from the Ontario government, Kingston's city council, and Kingstonians in general to erect a huge memorial fountain at the Frontenac County Court-House. It was formally presented in 1903 as the climax of the city's Homecomers' Festival.

Born on March 11 1919 at North Berwick, East Lothian, Iain Mark Tennant was descended from the Tennant line whose family wealth derived from the bleach works at Springburn, Glasgow. His father commanded the Royal Flying Corps in Mesopotamia at the end of the First World War.

He was educated at Eton and Magdalene College, Cambridge.

Commissioned into the 2nd Battalion Scots Guards in 1940, serving as an intelligence officer until being captured at Tobruk in 1942.

Initially incarcerated by the Italians, at Chieti on the Adriatic coast, Tennant was to experience three PoW camps in all. In these he served as security officer and sometimes on the escape committee.

After the Italian surrender Tennant was transferred to camps in Germany, remaining there until the end of the war. He left the Army in 1946, and in the same year married Lady Margaret Ogilvy, second daughter of the 12th Earl of Airlie.

Tennant's family had a holding in Caledonian Associated Cinemas, and he went to work there, soon joining the board as a non-executive director. The company won the franchise for the new Independent Television area in the north-east and Highlands of Scotland, and Grampian Television began broadcasting on September 30 1961; in 1968 Tennant was appointed chairman.

Board meetings under his aegis were notable for their brevity and location. He liked to visit the breadth of Grampian's transmission area, from Perthshire to Shetland, from Aberdeen to the Isles, and he held one meeting at his home in Moray.

Grampian prospered under Tennant, and he remained as chairman until 1989. Meanwhile, his business expertise was in demand elsewhere: he served on the boards of Times Publishing (1962-66) and Clydesdale Bank (1968-89), and was chairman of Seagram Distillers (1979-84).

He was also chairman of Glenlivet Distillers from 1964 to 1984 during a period of considerable expansion. Tennant toured the world on behalf of both the company and the industry, visiting 43 countries, and it

was a role in which he excelled. As a man who valued integrity and loyalty above all, however, he was outraged when the Imperial Group sold their shares in Glenlivet to the Seagram Corporation without first informing him. He never believed that large American companies could contribute anything to the Scotch whisky industry, and declared that he had been betrayed by what he called "City of London chicanery".

Tennant was a governor of Gordonstoun from 1951, and had the difficult task of dealing with the school's sometimes parlous finances and with the eccentricities of its founder, Kurt Hahn.

He was chairman of the governors from 1957 to 1970, which included the period during which Prince Charles was educated there. Sometimes the Prince would spend the weekend with Tennant and his wife at nearby Innes House.

A trusted friend of the Royal Family, Tennant had been - as a member of the Royal Company of Archersan usher at the Coronation. In Westminster Abbey he had to sit down on the steps below the pew he was looking after, and when he did so the trousers of his uniform split noisily up the backside. A peeress sitting above him leant down and confided: "If you want a needle and thread, I have one on my coronet."

Perhaps the job that Tennant most enjoyed was his role (from 1970 to 1990) as Crown Estate Commissioner for Scotland. He travelled to every corner of the country he loved, and was determined that the Crown lands should be managed in the best possible way.

lain Tennant was a man of old-fashioned courtesy and charm, but always alert to the possibilities of the new. Above all he had an unflinching dedication to public service and was devoted to his home county of Moray: in 1949, when he was 30, he founded Moray Sea School; he served his county as a councillor, and in 1963 he was appointed Lord Lieutenant for Moray, continuing in the role for 31 years.

In 1986 he was appointed a Knight of the Thistle.
